CONVENTION CONZINE GUIDELINES

We create the dream for each other. How true that statement! The magic that is Beauty and the Beast lives on through *your* efforts, *your* art and story. Make this 2018 conzine special with your submissions of stories, poetry, essays, films, and art. Whether it's your first attempt or your twentieth, your unique vision of love and hope is welcome, indeed ... *necessary*. So get busy; gift your fellow fans! Keep the dream alive! This traditional, printed zine will be a treasure to keep for always.

Remember – anything IS possible ... but not without you.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- ➔ **The deadline for inclusion in the conzine is April 1, 2018.** Small prizes will be awarded to those who send in their contributions early. If I have your work, be it story, poem, art, or essay, by March 15th, you'll get a little something in the mail. :-)
- ➔ All works must be original and cannot have been published or posted anywhere else, online or in hard copy.
- ➔ Submissions must be the submitter's own work. Quoted song lyrics, poetry, lines from literature, etc., must be clearly identified and credited.
- ➔ You may submit more than one story, poem, work of art, etc., however ...
- ➔ All individual contributions may be submitted only once (no subsequent versions accepted). Get all your tweaking out of your system before hitting send!
- ➔ Submissions from all categories will be considered: Classic, SND, 3S, Alternate Universe, Crossover, etc.
- ➔ Submissions with a maximum rating of strong -R- will be considered.
- ➔ Submissions relating to 3S and submissions with an -R- rating will be identified as such in the table of contents and on the work's title page.

STORIES/POETRY/ESSAYS

- ❖ Maximum length of 50 pages.
- ❖ Maximum rating: strong R (Plot, plot! Steamy romance with plot!)
- ❖ Stories will be edited for grammar and punctuation without notifying the author. Proposed edits of content will be discussed with the author.
- ❖ Use a standard font like Helvetica or Times New Roman (12-point).

- ❖ Use footnotes or document end-notes using the superscript number function of your word processing program. (Not in-line, within the body of your story).
- ❖ Make clear your pen name, if you use one.
- ❖ Written work may be submitted as an attached .doc, .docx, .rtf, or .odt file, or in Pages for Mac. (No .pdf files.)
- ❖ Illustrations can be inserted into your work. Go ahead and include them where you want, but please send the .jpg or .png images along as separate files as well. Sometimes illustrations don't "translate" from the original document.

ARTWORK

- ❖ Full-page art will be displayed on 8 1/2 x 11 paper in either landscape or portrait orientation. Create works with that maximum size in mind.
- ❖ Maximum rating: strong R
- ❖ Send artwork in .png format (best for drawings). If a .png isn't possible, send a high resolution .jpg. If your file is too large to attach to an email, use dropbox or Google Drive and send me the link to retrieve it.
- ❖ If you cannot scan the artwork yourself, contact me for assistance.
