À la carte dining on the terrace or indoors, at the golf course. Full meals, sandwiches, light snacks, and complete beverage service day and night.

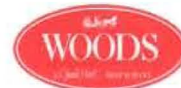


GRAND LUNCHEON BUFFET

Cupola Bar

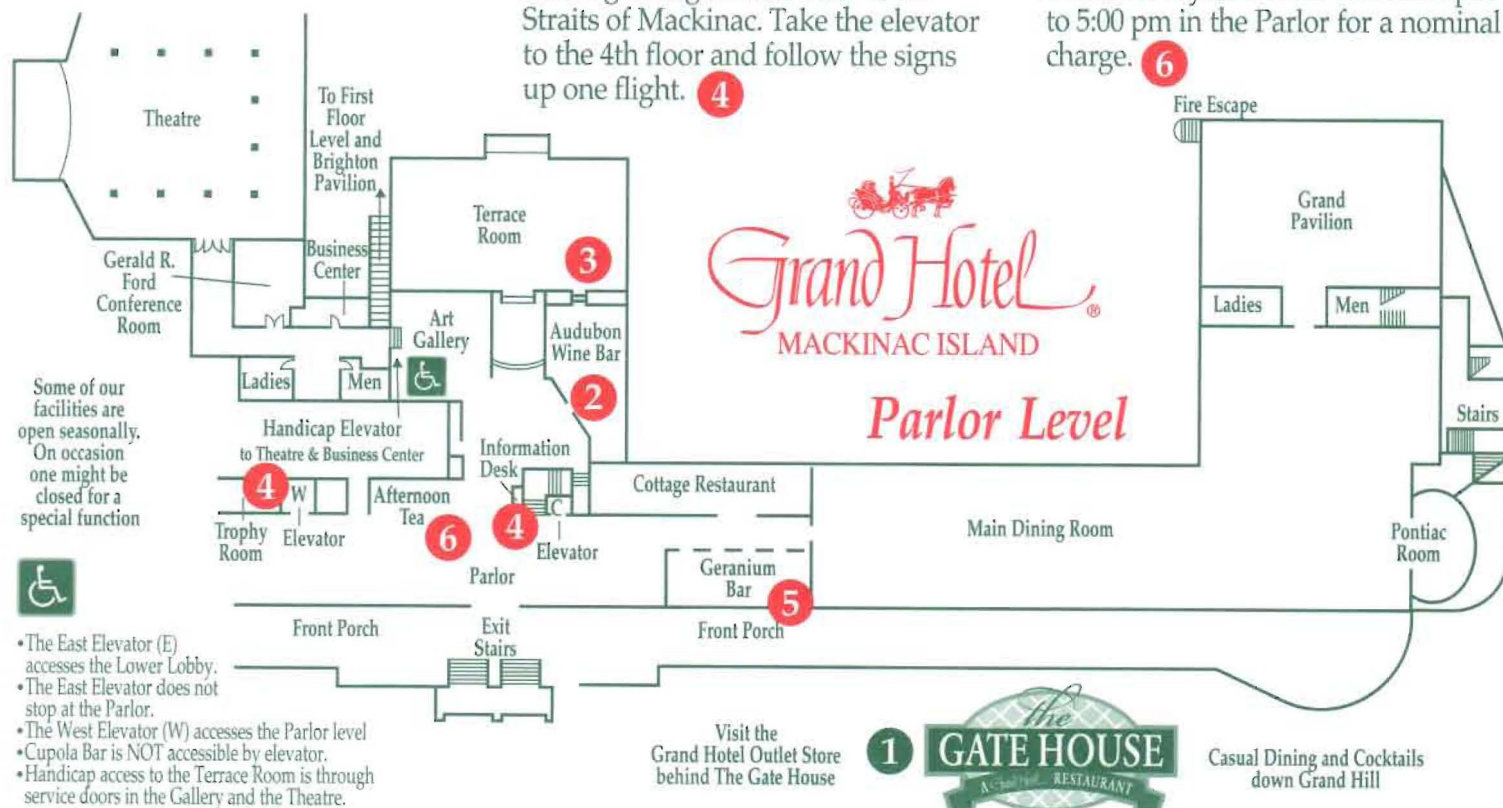

Some of our facilities are open seasonally. On occasion one might be closed for a special function



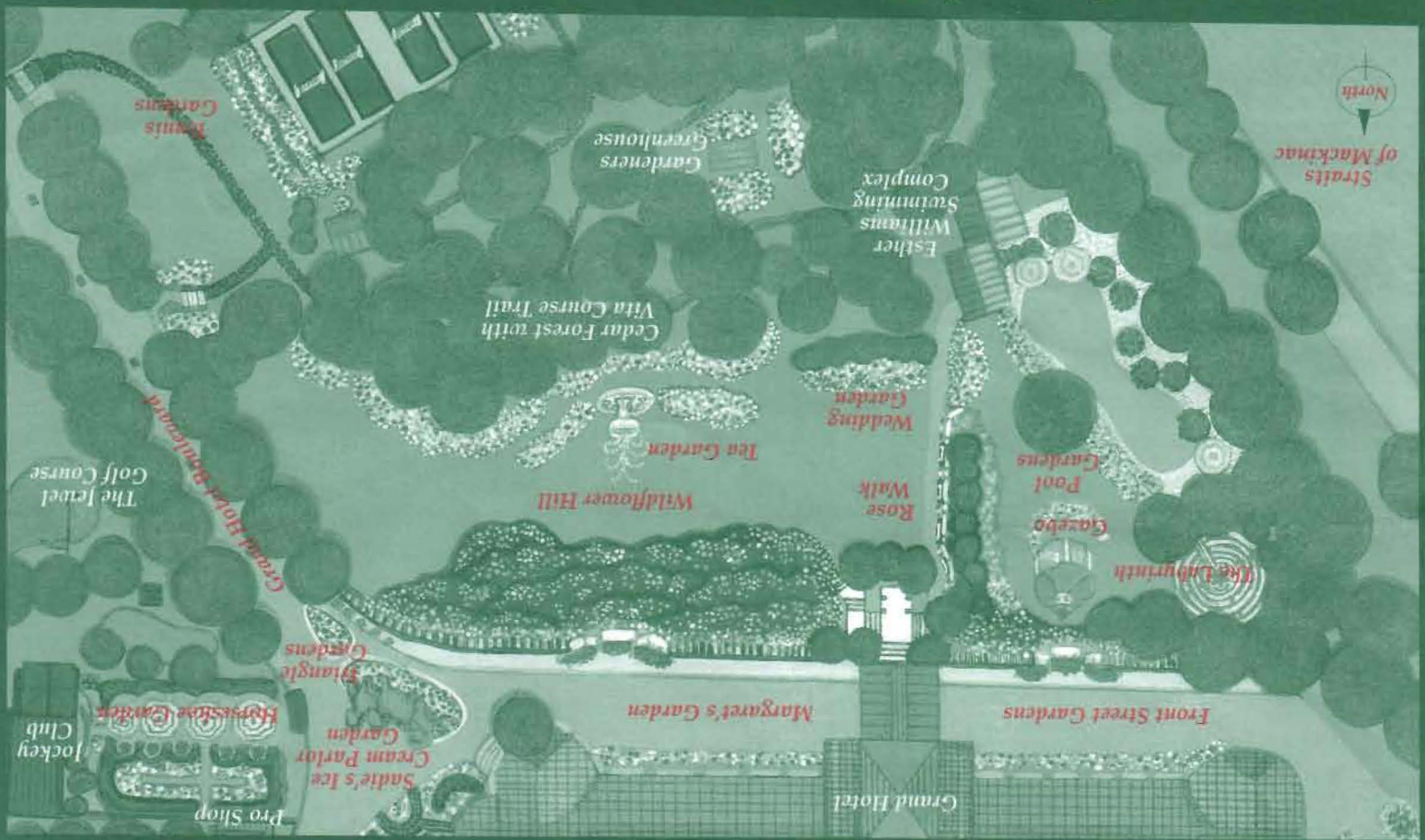
- The East Elevator (E) accesses the Lower Lobby.
